

Visitation

For infectious disease prevention and security reasons, all visitors to hospitalized patients are required to make an appointment in advance. We also ask all visitors to follow the rules below. We appreciate your understanding.

Persons who can visit our inpatients	Family member only
Visiting hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • between 2 and 4pm • up to 15 minutes/visit • By appointment only (see below)
Number of visitors	up to 3
How to make an appointment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You can only make an appointment on weekdays. • Appointments are accepted no later than 4pm the day before you wish to visit. • Please call the patients' ward to make an appointment and tell the nurse when you would like to visit the patient. • Please note that we may not be able to meet your request.
How to see our inpatients	<p>Weekdays : Please come to counter No.1. Weekends and Holidays : Please come to counter No.6.</p>
Notes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> ① Visitors are required to wear a facemask and disinfect their hands with alcohol spray when visiting an inpatient. ② Eating and drinking during visitation are prohibited. ③ Please avoid visiting patients if you are experiencing symptoms of an infection such as a fever, sore throat, diarrhea or vomiting. ④ You may not see our inpatient if he/she has a fever or other symptoms, or if there are other inpatients with infectious diseases in the ward.

We also receive and deliver goods for our inpatients. Please ask the front desk.
